2008 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

On behalf of the Officers and Directors of AFCEA Fort Monmouth Chapter, I am pleased to announce the annual Dr. Joseph Frank, Dr. Walter S. Mc Afee and Mrs. Barbara A. Fisher Scholarship Programs. Ten Dr. Frank Scholarships, five Dr. Mc Afee Scholarships of \$2,800 each (\$700 annually), and four Mrs. Barbara A. Fisher Technical Scholarships of \$1,400 each (\$700 annually) will be awarded to competitively selected high school seniors in Monmouth and Ocean Counties.

The MINIMUM criteria for consideration include:

- * **Be committed to pursuing a college degree relating to communications, computer science or electronics, in preparation for a career in Science or Engineering. (Civil, Mechanical, Bio-Medical Engineering are not related fields.)**
- * Be a graduating senior in a Monmouth or Ocean County High School.
- * Be in the top twenty-five percent of the class.
- * Be recommended by at least three high school personnel (teachers, counselors, or other appropriate individuals).
- * Have a good academic record in Physical Science, Computer Science, and Mathematics.
- * Be accepted by an accredited college into its Science or Engineering Program.
- * **Submit an essay of approximately 1000-1500 words on any aspect of the importance of Science or Engineering to our Nation's future.**

The letters of recommendation should describe the applicant's significant achievements and traits that illustrate his/her commitment and dedication to Science or Engineering. Relevant letters of recommendation from other sources, in addition to the three from the high school, may also be submitted.

If you are interested in competing for any of these Scholarships, please submit the Application Form, together with all required supporting documents to the address on the application, **no later than April 4, 2008**. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The Scholarship Committee will make its selections, and the awards will be presented the Awards Banquet on June 24, 2008.
